Group or class activity
Discussion, decision making, research, writing and art and design
Aim: To understand what is involved in sending books, to increase knowledge of sub-Saharan Africa

Part One	Group or class	<p>Download the “Journey of a Book Aid International book” sheet.</p> <p>Discussion questions:</p> <p>If you were to send 100 books to Uganda how long would it take? How would the books travel? What would you see along the way if you took the same journey? Why do you think Book Aid International only sends carefully chosen books? How much do you think it costs to send 1 book? (the answer is £2)</p>	<p>Download</p> <p>Journey of a Book Aid International book</p> <p>Map of Africa</p> <p>Uganda profile</p>
Part Two	Group	<p>Split the class into groups of 4 – 6 students.</p> <p>Create a wall chart which shows the journey of a Book Aid International book. Illustrate the journey of a Book Aid International book from the start of its journey in a publisher’s warehouse to the hands of a reader in Uganda.</p> <p>Each group could either:</p> <p>1) Illustrate one part of the journey which would join up with other charts made by the class.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>2) Illustrate the whole journey on one very large piece of paper.</p>
