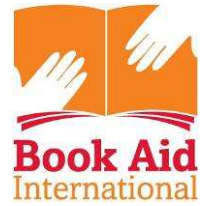


Journey of a Book Aid International book

A Book Aid International librarian will make sure that the book is useful and in tip-top condition. They will stamp it with a Book Aid International stamp and then it is time for.....



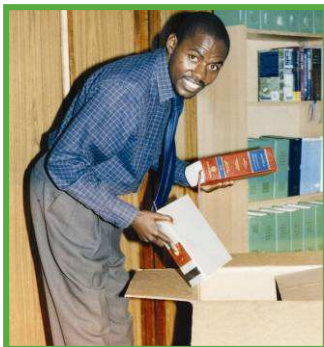
SHIPPING

The books are shipped to our partners in the countries where we work. They make sure that the books can get through customs and look after.....



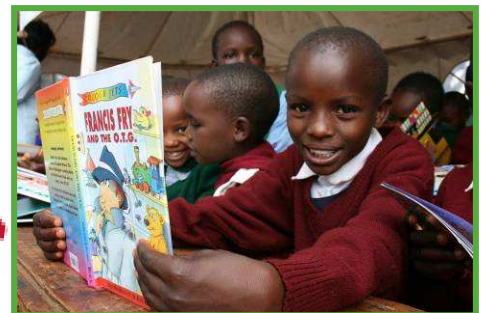
PACKING

Our partners send the books out to libraries, schools and universities. We always send books to places that have libraries so that the books can be read by lots of people and are looked after properly.
